## Jacob's Bay to Cape Columbine Sea Kayak Expedition

This sea kayak trip takes you from the sheltered waters of Jacob's Bay, along the coastline and around Cape Columbine to end near Paternoster. Nights will be cold but days should be clear and sunny. There is always a possibility of bad weather, so a windcheater and beanie are important.

### On Water

- Swimming costume
- Wet shoes – booties/strops/tackies
- Wetsuit (available for hire if required)
- Light anorak/windcheater
- Kikoi (less bulky than a towel)
- Sun block
- 2 strong black bags for waterproofing
- Camera (we provide dry bucket)

### Off Water

- Small Tent
- One warm change of clothes for the evenings – Base layer (thermal leggings and long-sleeved top. T-shirt, track pants and top, fleece jacket, closed shoes and socks, down jacket, anorak, beanie.
- Roll mat - closed cell foam or similar ('Therma-rests' are expensive but worth it!)
- Warm sleeping bag
- Small pillow (inflatable or 'stuffer')
- Toothbrush and toothpaste.
- Personal snacks (biltong, sweets, dried fruit)
