



DIRECTIONS TO THE ORANGE RIVER GORGE – WILD PARADISE RIVER CAMP

From Cape Town (about 763km)

1. Take the N1 in the direction of Paarl
2. Take the Malmesbury turn off – you're now on the N7
3. Drive past : Mooresburg, Piketburg, Citrusdal, Clanwilliam, Klaver, Van Rhynsdorp, Bitterfontein, Garies, Kamieskroon and turn off at Springbok.
4. Drive through Springbok town following the main road. At the bottom, carry on through past the Engen garage.
6. Drive 160km to Pofadder on the N14.
7. Drive through Pofadder and continue for 46kms on the N14
8. Take the 'Onseepkans' turn off to the left. There is a sign saying "Karsten Gasteploas". This is a tar road.
3. Continue around 42km until you reach a T- junction. (The road turns to dirt half way just after the 'Karsten Farm' turn off). Once you at the T-junction, take the Onseepkans turn off on to your right.
4. Continue about 8 km to the border post
9. Watch out for the big 'speed bumps' in the road – there are three of them.
11. The first building on your right is the police station. Directly ahead of you is the Border Control Building - Turn left at the Border Control building.
12. Follow the road for 100m or so, following the Gravity signs. The entrance to Wild Paradise Riverside Campsite is on the right. Your guides will be there to meet you. If they haven't arrived yet, settle in and make yourself at home.

Note 1: If using a GPS, the quickest route indicated to you from Cape Town might be the R358 from the N7 straight to Pofadder. This route is shorter, but it is ALL dirt and is extremely isolated – no towns at all and few farms.

Note 2: There is a shorter, more direct route from Pofadder to Onseepkans but this road is only suitable for higher clearance vehicles and can be in bad condition. It's a lovely route but please drive carefully and watch out for gates and cattle grids. The turn off is in Pofadder itself and is signposted "Onseepkans".

From JHB (about 1071km)

1. From Jo- Burg make your way to Upington.
2. Continue to Kakamas. This is the last place to fill up with petrol/diesel and also the last town for supplies. Continue through Kakamas for around 80km till you reach the Onseepkans turn off to your right. There is a sign saying "Karsten Gasteploas". This is a tar road.
3. Continue around 42km until you reach a T- junction. (The road turns to dirt half way just after the 'Karsten Farm' turn off). Once you at the T-junction, take the Onseepkans turn off on to your right.
4. Continue about 8 km to the border post
5. Continue from point 9, above
